In 2016, we, Christian Aid Ministries (CAM) and Centre for Caring, Empowerment and Peace Initiatives (CCEPI) partnered in a 1000 Vulnerable Widows and Orphans Project to supply relief aid to the displaced and disadvantaged victims of Boko Haram in Northeast Nigeria.

Together, with CCEPI as the implementing partner and CAM as the donor agency; food, non-food items, farming aid and houses were supplied to the victims to again allow them to go on with their lives.

The budgetary interventions of the project was \$653,537.50 USD.

The project was highly successful due to the expertise of the CCEPI staff. CCEPI was transparent at all levels of financial accountability. The funds were strictly used for the purpose they were given for, and followed by timely reports. CAM staff was always openly welcomed to participate at all levels of relief aid distribution.
